The Presentation of the Lord**

Dear Parish Family:

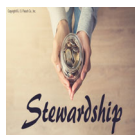
It is not every day that we get to hear from three different prophets, let alone three who see the Lord physically present in the temple. For Malachi, it is anticipatory: he foresees the day when the Lord will come to the temple to purify the people of the covenant.

In the letter to the Hebrews, we hear how this baby boy, whom Simeon held, could become the salvation of the world. He is God made flesh so that He could take our sins upon Himself, suffer and die for them and atone for them. When we receive Him in the Eucharist, we receive His Body and Blood, which He sacrificed to gain our salvation.

Jesus was revealed to the shepherds on the night He was born, then to the magi many days later and, as we celebrate the Presentation, He was made manifest to Simeon and Anna when He was presented in the temple according to the Law. Jesus continues to reveal Himself in the world every day.

My brothers and sisters in Christ, today’s feast reminds us that Jesus is the light that illumines the path to holiness. Let us pray for one another for a deeper reflection on God’s word, which will lead us to the light that can never be extinguished, the light of Christ.
