#### **MARRIAGES:**

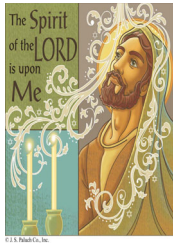
Parishioners arrangements must be made at least six months prior to the ceremony and before arranging the social plans.

**From Fr. Peter's Desk**  
**Third Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Dear Parish Family:

In our First Reading today from Nehemiah, we hear the recounting of the remarkable day five hundred years before the birth of Christ when Ezra read the book of the law (the Torah) to all of Jerusalem. The people, having just returned from their long exile, wept with gratitude as the Word of God washed over them.

In our Second Reading, St Paul reminds the Corinthians that they, although all quite different and unique, all make up the Body of Christ. We too, though gifted with many different personalities, talents and abilities, all make up that one body, the Body of Christ.

In our Gospel reading, Jesus reads Isaiah's calling and reinterprets it as His mission. He himself will fulfill all these things, bringing the Good News to those in need, freedom for those held captive by sin, healing to the sick and disabled, and a jubilee year for all. A jubilee year was a radical reversal of society, with slaves freed, debts forgiven, and property redistributed.

My brothers and sisters in Christ, this year the Church celebrated the Year of Hope. Let us live in the hope that Jesus' mission continues to be fulfilled in our world today.

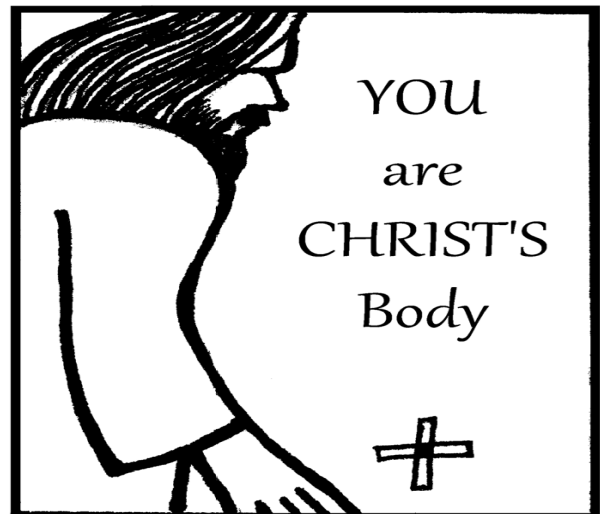

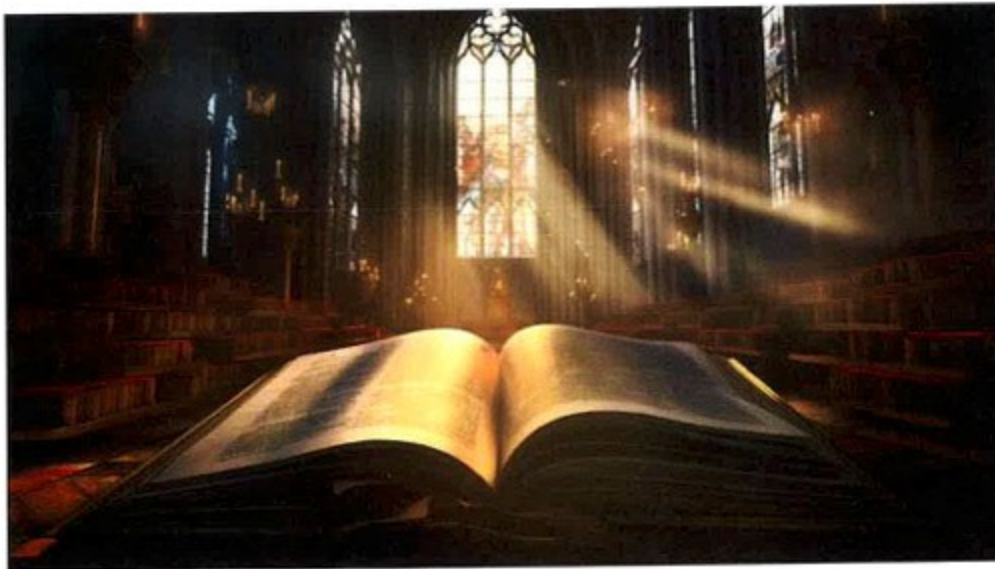
